

# Introduction

The Traffic Incident Management Enhancement Task Force (TIME) was formed to address the critical issues related to incident management in the region. This task force is made up of concerned incident responders from transportation agencies, fire, rescue, law enforcement, towing & recovery, emergency medical services, etc.

The mission of the TIME Task Force is to develop and sustain a region-wide incident management program to facilitate the safest and fastest roadway clearance, lessening the impact on emergency responders and the motoring public.

To help us accomplish our mission, the TIME Task Force was divided into three (3) committees:

- Program and Institutional Issues,
- Operational Issues, and
- Communication and Technology.

Subsequently, the **Operations Committee** was assigned to develop an Interstate Traffic Incident Response Directory.

This directory contains contact information, response assignments, and GIS jurisdictional maps highlighting the response assignments for each participating emergency service agency within Metro Atlanta.

The directory was designed to assist the Task Force in meeting our established goals of **Coordination, Communication, and Cooperation** between the various agencies within the region.
